Project Orphan



Project Orphan provides 200 meals monthly to this Hostel for boys in India.

The Hostel's purpose is to give these boys an education and also help them grow in the knowledge of the Word of Yahweh. To help them get saved first and then grow spiritually.

Every day during their devotional time the warden teaches them Bible stories and also helps them understand the salvation plan of Yahweh in the Bible. Many have made the decision and gotten baptized before leaving the Hostel. The Christian influences they experience during their time at the Hostel helps them to stand for their Savior when they get back home.

Every Sunday they attend the Sunday service by which they are exposed to the Biblical principals and worship which helps them to grow in the Messiah once they have made a decision for Him.

What has become of some of these boys?

Once they leave the Hostel, they go home to get jobs according to the education they received at the Hostel. Some of these boys go on to go to college. One of the boys finished his school final and is still in the Hostel going to college for Bachelor in Communications Degree. Some have started their own small businesses, gone on to Bible schools and get involved in some Christian Ministry.

Where do these boys come from?

Some of the boys come from their own church and daughter churches, from other churches, some from Hindu homes where they have no facility to go to school, or parents can not afford to pay their school fees and buy school supplies, and some are from broken homes.

Services the Hostel provides:

The Hostel provides free food, lodging, Christian love, care and education for these boys.

Daily Schedule:

Boys rise at 5:30 a.m.
Do their wash until 6:00
6:00 to 6:30 a.m. they have devotions
6:30 to 7:00 a.m. they have a coffee break
7:00 to 8:00 a.m. study time
They leave for school at 8:30 a.m. (taking lunch with them from the Hostel.)
4:30 to 6:00 p.m. they have free time and games
6:00 to 6:30 p.m. wash and prepare for evening study time
6:30 to 8:00 p.m. are study hours
8:00 to 8:30 p.m. supper
8:30 to 9:00 p.m. Evening Prayer, and 9:00 p.m. is lights out for bed.
