The Meaning of the Candy Cane

Many years ago a candy maker wanted to make a candy that symbolized the true meaning of Christmas-Yahshua. The hard candy was shaped like a shepherd's hook since JESUS is the Great Shepherd. When turned upside down it is shaped like a "J" to represent JESUS' name. The color white stands for the pureness of JESUS. The solid red color represents the blood HE shed to save US from our sins. The stripped red color is to represent Isaiah 53:5, "by HIS stripes WE are healed." The three different colors represent Yahshua being part of the Trinity. The peppermint flavor represents HIS death and resurrection.
